Bucket Challenge

Overview

Using only the materials provided, teams must transport as much water as possible from one point to another while overcoming the obstacles laid out in this challenge. Team with the most water wins.

Objective

Communication plays a key role in this activity. Every team member will play a vital role in planning, supporting and executing their plans.



Tug of War



Overview

Teams will compete against each other to pull the rope over a line marked on the ground and the team that achieves it wins.

Objective

While this is a great way to test the raw strength of the team members, teams can only win this activity when they channel their collective team efforts towards a common goal. By doing so, they will harness the power of alignment which changes their perspective and helps them to focus on what they want most from a place of empowerment, belief and certainty to win this activity.

String Me Along

Overview

Teams will have to use pens attached to strings to scribble the words - 'Royal Albatross' on a white sheet. The team that finishes first wins.

Objective

This activity relies on teamwork and drives home the point that no member of the team can complete a goal alone and will require collaboration and strategic planning between the team members to achieve their goals.

Raise the Sail

Overview

Participants will rotate between the different roles of the sailing crew to handle the lines and sails. Teams must work in unison throughout the sail-handling in this activity.

Objective

This activity will allow team members to understand each other's strengths and weaknesses and will encourage them to work through it towards a common goal. The crew will continue to monitor the safety of the participants as they engage in this activity.

Tie the Knot

Overview

In this activity, teams will use one hand to tie a knot as difficult as possible and challenge the opposing team to remove them. Teams that remove the knots in the shortest time wins.

Objective

This activity builds leadership, time management and problem-solving skills. It also provides the avenue for teams to value each other's ideas. Usually brainstorming sessions tends to sway towards the vocal and dominant personalities even though other team members have valuable ideas. This activity will encourage ideas to have an equal footing and each team member's ability to contribute is further established.
