

### **Precautionary Measures in Response to Novel Coronavirus**

The Royal Albatross is an outdoor dining venue on an open deck that is very well ventilated with fresh sea breezes; therefore the risk infection is low. That said, and although there has been no reported cases on-board our ship or in its vicinity, the management team of the Royal Albatross is taking proactive steps to minimize any infection risks and for the safety of all persons on-board. We seek your understanding and full cooperation to implement the following steps that we trust should not affect your enjoyment of our dinner cruise experience.

- 1) During registration, to allow our team take your temperature to ensure its normal.
- 2) Prior to embarkation, all guests shall be required to cleanse their hands using the provided sanitizer.
- 3) Should you feel any onset of flu like symptoms such as coughing, sneezing or temperature/fever during the cruise, to immediately request and wear a face mask.

Face masks shall be available free of charge from our staff upon request. Our crew, service staff and in-house kitchen staff will be monitored closely for any symptoms - before they board the ship, at the start their duties and every few hours.

We will still continue to review reports from the Ministry of Health (MOH) and follow their recommendations and guidelines, while monitoring the situation with the relevant authorities and follow their advice accordingly.
