TERMS & CONDITIONS FOR PARTICIPATION IN ACTIVITIES AT LAZARUS SEA SPORTS CENTRE

These Terms and Conditions ("T&Cs") govern the participation in activities and use of the Lazarus Sea Sports Centre ("Venue"), operated by Camelot Pte Ltd ("Camelot") and Tall Ship Adventures Pte Ltd ("TSA"). By purchasing and or participating in any activity, event, or cruise offered at the Venue, you ("Patron") agree to abide by and be legally bound by these T&Cs.

1. Eligibility and Health Requirements

1.1 Eligibility Criteria

Activities at the Venue are not recommended for individuals who fulfil any of the following criteria and therefore TSA shall not be liable in the event of death or injury sustained at the Venue:

- Exceed 130 kilograms (286 pounds) in weight.
- Suffer from any medical conditions or injury that impairs their ability to participate in physical activities
- Are children under 8 years of age.
- Are elderly individuals above the age of 65.
- Are expectant mothers.

1.2 Children's Participation

- Children under 8 years of age must be accompanied by a responsible adult and seated in the middle row of the vehicle, wearing the provided Personal Flotation Device ("PFD"), with a signed waiver from their parent or guardian.
 - Children aged 8 to 12 years must be supervised by an adult at a ratio of at least 1 adult to 2 children.

2. Entry Conditions at Lazarus Sea Sports Centre

2.1 Identification and Admission

- Patrons may be required to present valid photo identification ("ID") for verification at the time of entry.
- Admission may be denied to persons under the age of 13 unless accompanied by a responsible adult (aged 18 or older).

2.2 Prohibited Items

- The following items are strictly prohibited within the Venue:
 - Alcohol or illegal drugs.
 - Glassware or sharp objects.
 - Smoking, vaping, or use of e-cigarettes.

- Any Patron found with prohibited items may be refused entry or removed from the Venue without refund.

2.3 Damage to Property

- Patrons are financially responsible for any damage to or loss of equipment or property at the Venue, and shall promptly compensate TSA or Camelot for any such loss or damage, including damage to the Venue itself.

2.4 Operating Hours and Activity Time

- Water activities cease promptly at 4:00 PM or 5:00 PM as advised by TSA and all Patrons must return to shore by these times.
 - Last rentals for watercraft are at 3:00 PM or 4:00 PM as advised by TSA and Patrons will have a maximum of one hour of activity time.

3. Health, Safety & Behavioural Guidelines

3.1 Safety Equipment

- All Patrons are required to use the safety equipment provided by TSA or Camelot during any water activity, including but not limited to PFDs, and must follow all instructions given by TSA or Camelot staff.

3.2 Personal Responsibility

- Adults are responsible for the safety, supervision, and conduct of children and individuals under their care.
- Patrons must act responsibly and in accordance with all reasonable instructions and safety guidelines provided by TSA and Camelot staff, including the Beachmaster, Duty Officer, or instructors.

3.3 Weather Conditions and Emergency Procedures

- The Venue and the Company reserve the right to suspend or discontinue any activity due to unsafe weather conditions, including but not limited to storms or lightning. In such cases, all Patrons must return to shore immediately upon activation of the Lightning Warning System (Light and Siren).

3.4 Medical Conditions

- Patrons with pre-existing medical conditions or concerns should seek medical advice prior to participating in activities. By participating, Patrons confirm their ability to safely engage in the activity.

3.5 Liability and Risk Acceptance

- Participation in the activities at the Venue involves inherent risks, including but not limited to personal injury or death. By entering the Venue and participating in any activity, Patrons

voluntarily accept all associated risks and agree to hold TSA, Camelot, and their affiliates harmless for any injury, loss, or death resulting from such risks.

4. Environmental Responsibility

4.1 Leave No Trace

- Patrons are required to follow a “Carry In, Carry Out” policy, meaning all personal waste must be removed from the Venue to preserve the natural environment.

4.2 Marine Life Protection

- Patrons must maintain a safe distance from marine animals, coral reefs, and other fragile ecosystems. Touching, feeding, or disturbing wildlife is strictly prohibited.

4.3 Watercraft Handling

- Patrons must carry, not drag, watercraft when entering or exiting the water, in order to protect seagrass beds and marine habitats.

4.4 Designated Zones

- Patrons must adhere to the designated launch and return zones as specified by TSA and Camelot. Any activity outside these areas is strictly prohibited.

5. Cancellation, Postponement & Changes

5.1 Weather-Related Cancellations

- The Cruise is intended to operate regardless of weather conditions; however, TSA reserves the right to cancel or postpone activities if conditions are deemed unsafe for participation. No compensation will be provided for cancellations due to weather, unless otherwise specified.

5.2 Event Cancellation

- TSA and Camelot reserve the right to cancel, postpone, or interrupt any scheduled event or activity due to unforeseen circumstances, including maintenance, safety concerns, or other operational issues. In such cases, no compensation will be offered, except for a rescheduled event or activity.

6. Right to Refuse Entry and Removal

6.1 Grounds for Refusal

TSA and Camelot reserve the right to refuse entry to or remove any person from the Venue under the following circumstances:

- The Patron fails to comply with these T&Cs or the instructions of TSA or Camelot staff.
- The Patron is deemed to be intoxicated, disorderly, or engaging in disruptive behaviour.
- The Patron attempts to bring prohibited items into the Venue or engages in activities that compromise safety or security.

6.2 Removal for Misconduct

- Any Patron who engages in vandalism, theft, or any form of offensive or disruptive behaviour may be immediately removed from the Venue and banned from returning, without refund.

7. Exclusion of Liability

7.1 Limitation of Liability

- TSA and Camelot shall not be liable for any personal injury, loss, or damage to property incurred by any Patron during their participation in activities at the Venue, except where such injury or loss is caused directly by the negligence or wilful misconduct of TSA or Camelot.
 - Patrons acknowledge that they participate in activities at their own risk and waive all claims against TSA, Camelot, and their affiliates for any resulting personal injury, illness, or death.

8. Miscellaneous

8.1 Amendments to T&Cs

- TSA and Camelot reserve the right to modify, amend, or update these T&Cs at any time, with such amendments taking effect immediately upon publication.

8.2 Governing Law

- These T&Cs are governed by the laws of the Republic of Singapore, and any disputes arising from the interpretation or enforcement of these T&Cs shall be subject to the exclusive jurisdiction of the Singapore courts.
